DIRECTIONS:

The Fort Lupton Historic Park and Rendezvous site is located along the scenic South Platte River just north of Fort Lupton, Colorado. The Park and Rendezvous site is approximately ½ mile west of Highway 85 on County Road 14 on the north side. Driving distances make it an easy day trip for those along the Front Range of Colorado. (Mileages are approximate.) • 9 miles west of Interstate 76 on Highway 52 • 10 miles east of Interstate 25 • 30 miles from DIA, Denver, Boulder, and Greeley • Less than one hour's drive north of most locations in the Denver Metro area.
